### Legendary Rulers

Tan'gun Chosŏn 壇君朝鮮 or Wanggŏm Chosŏn 王儉朝鮮 (ca. 2333–2334 B.C.E.)

Kija Chosŏn 箕子朝鮮 (ca. 1120 B.C.E.)

### Bronze Age States and Tribal Peoples

Old Chosŏn 古朝鮮 (5th century–194 B.C.E.)

Wiman Chosŏn 衛滿朝鮮 (194–108 B.C.E.)

Puyŏ 扶餘 (ca. 2nd century B.C.E.–346 C.E.)

Chin 辰 (first mentioned 2nd century B.C.E.)

### Three Kingdoms Period (*samguk* 三國, ca. 300–668)

Koguryŏ 高句麗 (traditional dates, 37 B.C.E.–668 C.E.)

Paekche 百濟 [from Mahan 馬韓] (traditional dates, 18 B.C.E.–660 C.E.)

Silla 新羅 [from Chinhan 辰韓] (traditional dates, 57 B.C.E.–935 C.E.)

High Antiquity 上古 (57 B.C.E.–514 C.E.)

Middle Antiquity 中古 (514–654 C.E.)

Late Antiquity 下古 (654–935 C.E.)

Kaya 加耶 [from Pyŏnhan 弁韓] (assimilated into Silla, 532–562)

Karak 駕洛 or Pon Kaya 本加耶 (traditional dates, 42–532 C.E.)

Imna 任那 or Tae Kaya 大加耶 (traditional dates, 42–562 C.E.)

### Northern and Southern Dynasties (*nambukkuk* 南北國)

Silla 新羅 or Unified Silla 統一新羅 (668 or 676–935)

Parhae 渤海 (698–926)

### Later Three Kingdoms (*hu samguk* 後三國)
